*CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS

One: Blessed be the Holy Trinity, ♣ one God, who forgives all our sin, whose mercy endures forever. It is our tradition to have a prayer of confession each week—not to harp on ourselves or to drum up guilt, but because we believe God is not done with us yet, that God is always listening, and that God's grace is always available. Let us pray together:

All: Merciful and loving God, we are your stiff-necked people. We trample on the needy. We grumble about your grace to others. We turn away from the poor. Have mercy on us and forgive our sins. Rejoice over us as ones who were lost and have been found.

(Pause for silent, personal confession and reflection)

One: Even when we are faithless, God remains faithful.

Jesus Christ came into the world to save sinners.

We who were lost have been found.

In the name of Jesus, our sins are forgiven!

All: Thanks be to God
