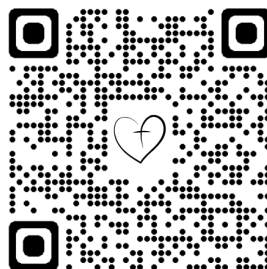
OUR VISION
